UNESCO World Heritage: Preserving appreciation.



The Hallstatt-Dachstein/Salzkammergut Alpine region is an exceptional example of a natural landscape of unique beauty and special scientific significance, bearing witness to early and continuous human, economic and cultural activities. -UNESCO Committee: December 1997

The World Heritage Site Inner Salzkammergut is not a museum. It is a habitat, geologically formed by ancient seas and culturally grown by more than 7,000 years of salt history. Nature has left salt, ammonites, and huge caves in the mountain. The cultural history is reflected in numerous original sites and archaeological finds. Human beings are the guardian of the World Heritage Site, carrying it into the future and caring for it. Take your time and discover the many facets of the World Heritage Site in the Dachstein Salzkammergut.

A little history

Since prehistoric times, people in Hallstatt have been digging for salt with simple "axes" made from deer antlers. To explore the many historical sites and finds, take a trip to the oldest salt mine in the world, hike to various places of happiness or visit excavations, museums and the many scattered sites in the area.

Customs and Traditions

The somewhat isolated valley has developed relatively independently over the centuries. This has given rise to characteristic customs and traditions that are still practised today. An important focus of the region is living craftsmanship. During the many traditional events that take place throughout the year, locals and visitors alike can not only admire craftsmanship and tradition, but also enjoy the region's famous folk music.

The boat on Lake Hallstatt Intangible cultural heritage

This historic type of boat is made entirely by hand and was used as a working boat on Lake Hallstatt 500 years ago. The "Fuhr", as it is called in Hallstatt, is a long boat with a shallow draught, which makes it possible to transport goods up and down the lake. Today they are mostly used for private purposes. With "NAVIA Zillenschifffahrt" you can enjoy the unique atmosphere of the past from Obertraun or Hallstatt.

Traditional attire: "Dirndl & Lederhose"

"Dirndl and Lederhose" are still worn as a matter of course in the World Heritage Region, especially on festive occasions.

Glöckler runs in the region



Wind along icy streams whose gentle murmur breaks the winter silence, or through fairytale forests where every step is accompanied by fresh snow.




