





# **RETTENBACHALM**

WILD-ROMANTIC ALPINE LANDSCAPE



Just a few kilometers from the center of Bad Ischl, the wildly romantic Rettenbachtal opens up to reveal one of the largest low pastures in Europe.

This magnificent landscape is a popular summer excursion destination for hikers and mountain bikers. Where cows graze in summertime, you can glide on snow in the winter season along cross-country ski trails, offering a small paradise for ski tourers and snowshoe hikers alike.

Enjoy the cozy alpine inn where you can experience the local cuisine! Next to the inn, there are also other alpine huts that are open in summer. Hike the extensive trails or embark on a tour to the Ischler hut.



# Two themed paths lead past the Perneck village square along old mine tunnels.

The roundwalk is 5.7 kilometers long and takes approximately 3 hours to complete. Additionally, the Reinfalz round is a possible hiking trail, stretching 10.2 kilometers with an estimated walking time of around 4 hours and 30 minutes. These routes offer insights into past times and the history of salt mining.

Another intriguing, themed trail along the 'Soleleitung' (brine pipeline) leads from the Perneck village square back to the city center of Bad Ischl.

# The approximately 10-hectare and 15-meter-deep Lake Nussen is one of the most important local recreation areas for the nearby town of Bad Ischl.

Designated as a natural reserve, the clear lake surrounded by forests radiates tranquility and natural beauty. There are various beautiful hikes available, including one around the lake and an extended hike leading back to the city center of Bad Ischl (approximately 7 kilometers), or further to Lake Wolfgang, almost 9 kilometers away.

# TO THE KATRINALM

CULINARY DELIGHTS ON BAD ISCHL'S LOCAL MOUNTAIN





For decades now Friday mornings have been a tradition in Bad Ischl. They are entirely in the spirit of the weekly market.

The diverse culinary and, above all, regional offering ranges from fruit and vegetables to meat and sausage specialties to bread, pastries and fish.

Not to be overlooked are the countless traditional costumes on "traditional costume Friday", which is popular with young and old. This festival day has a long tradition in the Salzkammergut and is still celebrated nowadays.

Especially at weekends and on public holidays, the "Katrin"- Ischl's local mountain - is a popular excursion destination for locals and guests.

The various hiking opportunities and culinary highlights in the "Almgasthaus" and "Almhütte" attract countless guests. The cable car takes just 15 minutes to reach Bad Ischls popular mountain.







The Salzkammergut shuttle service makes it also possible to easily get the to the weekly market – also from far outside the center like "Eck" (Route 620), the "Robinson Siedlung" (Route 610), or "Lindau" (Route 610).

4 EXCURSION SUGGESTIONS IN THE HOLIDAY REGION DACHSTEIN SALZKAMMERGU

WORLD HERITAGE TOUR

ON WALK THROUGH HALLSTATT



A local tour through 7.000 years of eventful history. Our World Heritage tour starts at the small parking lot in the north of the village, directly on the lake.

After a few hundred meters we reach the world-famous photo spot with the idyllic postcard view with village, church tower and Lake Hallstatt – vou definitely can't miss a selfie here! The road continues to the historic market square, past the waterfall and the World Heritage Museum. Continue along the lake to Hallstatt-Lahn. There is another wonderful view over the lake and the surrounding mountains.

Either you visit the salt mines with the famous "world heritage view"- platform, or walk back to the market square, via the "covered stairs" up to the Catholic church with the famous ossuary. A nice, scary event, which makes you enjoy your life even more on the way back in one of the local cafés or restaurants.

DACHSTEIN VIEW AND CULINARY HIGHLIGHTS



At 1000 meters above sea level a green oasis lies unnoticed above Bad Goisern. This cozy 1.5-hour-long hike begins at the Predigstuhl station. The path leads past alpine pastures through dense spruce forests to the "Rossmoosalm" which is managed by the farmer's wife on special days during summer.

Here you also get the first glimpses of the impressive Dachstein glacier. On the way to the Rossmoosalm you come past the "Zwerchwand quarry", an impressive rock fall which is now a paradise for climbers. A narrow path leads through this archaic rocky landscape with a great view of Lake Hallstatt. To the crowning glory at the end, you reach "Hütteneckalm", where in addition to culinary delights, there is a playground with a rabbit enclosure waiting for the small and large guests. Getting back you can take the same route or the "Rehmöser forest road" to our starting point.

# S INFO SHUTTLE-SERVICE

The **Salzkammergut shuttle service route 710** brings you easily to the start of this circular hiking trail. You can get information from our tourism offices.

Hike through the Green Heart of Obertraun. Immediately after the start at the Koppenrast Inn you reach one of the highlights of this hike: the "Koppelwinklerlacke". This small pond is a natural jewel, depending on the water level of the Bühlerbach, which comes directly from the Dachstein glacier. The valley and the associated "Koppenwinkelalm" are the green heart of Obertraun.

Continue along the river Traun, through the town of Obertraun and pass the Austrian Sports Resort BFSZ Obertraun to the train station. You can already find your way back here to the starting point – which would be a shame because then you miss the beautiful "Obertrauner high path". This is a narrow path above of the town which leads back to the starting point and the Koppenrast Inn.

# **NATURAL JUWEL LÖCKENMOOS**

THE LÖCKENHOCHMOOR AT GOSAU



# The Löckenhochmoor in Gosau is a true natural treasure and an untouched piece of earth.

At the starting point the path up to "Moosalm" in Gosau begins at "Badstum hut". Once at the top, the circular route begins around the Löckenmoos marsch, partly on roots paths, partly on wooden walkways with information boards with interesting details about the marsh landscape and wildlife.

You should not leave the created paths, not to endanger protected plants and animals. The impressive mountain range "Gosaukamm" is reflected at the highest point of the hike. The circular path continues to "Hintere Grubalm", from where the newly built forest road leads back to the Badstum Hut. From the hut you get back down into the valley to Gosau and back to the starting point.
